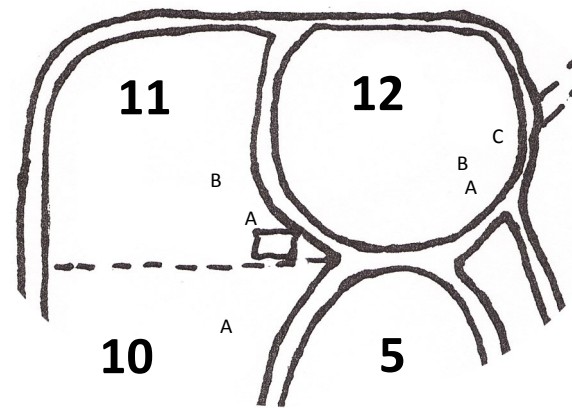


Arcade Rural Cemetery

At the time these young men enlisted to serve in the War Between the States, Arcade was known as China, New York. Our best theory for the origination of the name is that "China" was the title of several popular hymn tunes when the settlement became a separate town in 1818. The name was changed to Arcade in 1866.

Arcade Rural Cemetery Civil War Graves

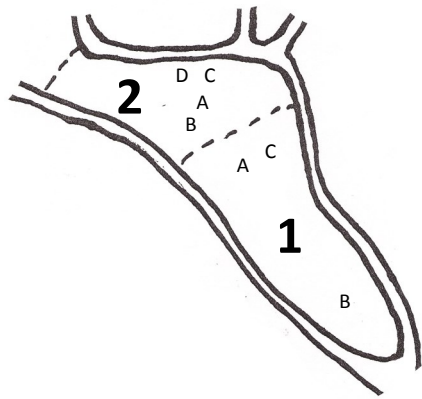


Left: Abel Clough's gravestone.
Right: his brother-in-law Newton Welles' gravestone.

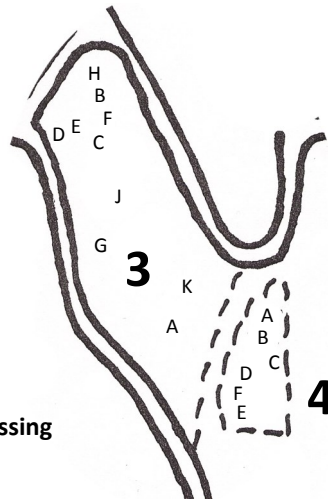

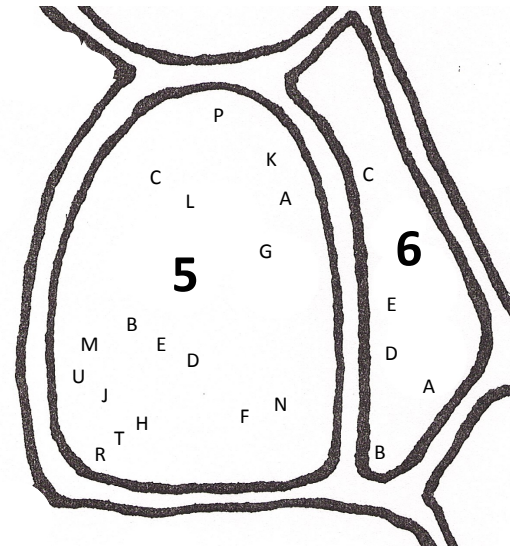

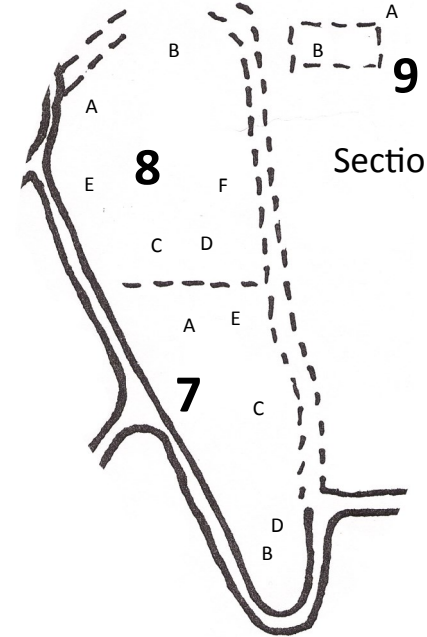
